3	DIRECTOR GANS: Call to order the
4	Open Meeting of the Monarch Fire Protection
5	District Board of Directors.
6	Would you please rise and join
7	Director Millner in the Pledge of Allegiance?
8	(Whereupon, all persons joined in reciting
9	the Pledge of Allegiance, after which time, the
10	following proceedings were had.)
11	DIRECTOR MILLNER: Thank you. We're
12	trying to figure out what toppings we want on the
13	(one word not clear) order.
14	DIRECTOR GANS: Sorry.
15	Approval of Agenda.
16	Are there any additions to the
17	Agenda?
18	DIRECTOR MILLNER: I have none.
19	ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: I have none.
20	DIRECTOR MILLNER: I'm sorry. Did
21	you say something?
22	DIRECTOR GANS: No, that's fine.
23	DIRECTOR MILLNER: Okay.
24	DIRECTOR HARRIS: I'm having
25	problems.

- 1 DIRECTOR GANS: Chief Spiegel, do
- 2 you have anything to add?
- 3 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: No, sir, I
- 4 have none.
- 5 DIRECTOR GANS: Maybe you do?
- 6 DIRECTOR HARRIS: Yes. That item
- 7 you and I spoke of, earlier, why don't you add
- 8 that to your report?
- 9 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Oh, yes. I'm
- 10 sorry.
- 11 DIRECTOR HARRIS: The additional
- 12 crew.
- 13 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Deployment.
- 14 Yes.
- 15 DIRECTOR GANS: All right. Under
- 16 Chief's Report, add item "E., Deployment To
- 17 Houston."
- 18 And I have nothing to add.
- 19 So we will now move on to the
- 20 President's Report.
- 21 Tonight, we have two swearing-in
- 22 ceremonies and this is one of the more exciting
- things that Directors get to do, especially, when
- there are two in one night.
- 25 And both are newly joining the Fire

- 1 District and we're going to welcome them with the
- 2 oath of office.
- So, if you'll give me a moment, I'm
- 4 going to come around to the front.
- 5 I'm gonna -- hold on. Sorry.
- I'm going to reverse the order; this
- 7 is not an amplified mic, but it's recorded, and
- 8 ask for Nick Govero to come forward.
- 9 Right there.
- And, at this time, I'm going to
- 11 administer the Oath of Office.
- 12 Nick is one of our newest
- 13 paramedic/firefighters and he currently has
- 14 family here. Quite a few people who appear to
- 15 know you.
- 16 So, as soon as we finish this, then
- 17 we'll ask for whoever you choose to come up and
- 18 pin your badge on you.
- 19 So, if you will raise your right
- 20 hand please, and repeat after me.
- 21 (Whereupon, the following Oath of Office
- was taken by Firefighter/Paramedic Nick Govero.)
- 23 NICK GOVERO: "I, Nick Govero,
- 24 Firefighter/Paramedic, do solemnly swear that I
- will uphold and support the Rules and Regulations

- 1 and Policies of the Monarch Fire Protection
- 2 District, its residents and visitors in need, the
- 3 Constitution of the State of Missouri and of the
- 4 United States of America.
- 5 "I will fulfill the duties of my
- 6 office to the best of my ability, so help me
- 7 God."
- 8 (Generous applause.)
- 9 DIRECTOR GANS: And whoever you've
- 10 asked to come up and turn on your badge, will
- 11 that person come forward?
- What a surprise.
- 13 NICK GOVERO: Yeah.
- 14 DIRECTOR GANS: Okay. Good choice.
- 15 (At this point, the badge was pinned on,
- 16 followed by generous applause.)
- 17 DIRECTOR GANS: So, at this time, if
- 18 the Director would stay up here?
- Nick, come back.
- 20 Other Directors and chief officers?
- 21 (Photos were taken, followed by the
- 22 swearing-in of Director Millner.)
- 23 DIRECTOR GANS: Now, we're going to
- 24 take a recess, so there'll be time for other
- 25 pictures, too.

- 1 So, at this time, I'm going to ask
- 2 Director Millner to stay up here. Everyone else,
- 3 stand by.
- 4 Stand here, so the audience can see.
- 5 DIRECTOR MILLNER: I'm here.
- 6 DIRECTOR GANS: He thinks he's a
- 7 Director.
- 8 DIRECTOR MILLNER: I know it. He
- 9 doesn't have any power.
- 10 DIRECTOR GANS: Did you hear that?
- 11 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Who --
- 12 DIRECTOR GANS: He thinks you're a
- 13 Director, huh?
- 14 (General chuckles.)
- 15 DIRECTOR GANS: For those of you who
- 16 don't know, Jean Millner is our newest Director
- 17 and she's actually already began serving on the
- 18 Board, the beginning of the month, so this is not
- 19 her first meeting, but this is her official Oath
- of Office, at the Fire District swearing-in.
- So, Jean, if you will please raise
- your right hand and repeat after me.
- 23 (Whereupon, the following Oath of Office
- was taken by Director Millner.)
- DIRECTOR MILLNER: "I, Jean Millner,

- 1 Director, do solemnly swear that I will uphold
- 2 and support the Rules and Regulations and
- 3 Policies of the Monarch Fire Protection District,
- 4 its residents and visitors in need, the
- 5 Constitution of the State of Missouri and of the
- 6 United States of America.
- 7 "I will fulfill the duties of my
- 8 office to the best of my ability, so help me
- 9 God."
- 10 DIRECTOR GANS: Congratulations.
- 11 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Thank you.
- 12 (Generous applause.)
- 13 DIRECTOR GANS: And we don't really
- 14 have an official badge for Directors. We have
- 15 badges, but they don't get pinned on.
- So, at this time, I will ask for the
- 17 same group to please come forward for a picture
- and then we'll do family pictures afterwards.
- 19 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Sure.
- 20 DIRECTOR GANS: Okay.
- 21 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Absolutely.
- 22
- What a surprise.
- NICK GOVERO: Yeah.
- DIRECTOR GANS: Okay. Good choice.

- 1 (At this point, the badge was pinned on,
- 2 followed by generous applause.)
- DIRECTOR GANS: So, at this time, if
- 4 the Director would stay up here?
- Nick, come back.
- 6 Other Directors and chief officers?
- 7 (Photos were taken, followed by the
- 8 swearing-in of Director Millner.)
- 9 DIRECTOR GANS: Now, we're going to
- 10 take a recess, so there'll be time for other
- 11 pictures, too.
- 12 At this time, we're going to take a
- 13 recess and have a brief reception.
- Our reception is in the kitchen, so
- 15 if you will follow Deputy Chief Harper back to
- 16 the kitchen, there are refreshments and we are in
- 17 recess and off the record.
- 18 (Whereupon, at 7:15 p.m. a brief recess was
- 19 taken, after which time, at 7:26 p.m., the
- 20 following proceedings were had.)
- 21 DIRECTOR GANS: Call back to order
- the Open Meeting of the Monarch Fire Protection
- 23 District Board of Directors.
- 24 And we continue, on the Agenda, with
- 25 the Secretary's -- well, that completed the

- 1 President's Report. We continue with the
- 2 Secretary's Report.
- 3 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Okay. I have
- 4 Meeting Minutes.
- I would like to make a motion that
- 6 we approve the Meeting Minutes of the Open Board
- 7 Meeting, August 17th, 2017.
- 8 The -- as well as the Open Meeting
- 9 of August 22nd, 2017; the Closed Meeting of
- 10 August 17th, 2017 and August 22nd, 2017.
- 11 DIRECTOR GANS: You need to separate
- 12 the Open and Closed.
- DIRECTOR MILLNER: I did the Open,
- 14 then I did the Closed.
- 15 DIRECTOR GANS: Two separate
- 16 motions.
- 17 DIRECTOR HARRIS: It's two separate
- 18 motions.
- DIRECTOR MILLNER: Oh, I'm sorry.
- 20 All right. I made a motion that we
- 21 approve the Minutes of the Open Board Meeting of
- 22 August 27th, 2017 and August 22nd, 2017.
- 23 I would also like to make a motion
- that we approve the Minutes of the Closed Board
- 25 --

- 1 DIRECTOR GANS: No. Two separate
- 2 motions. One at a time. So -- so you need to --
- 3 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Okay. Can I get
- 4 a second, please?
- 5 DIRECTOR GANS: Can you withdraw
- 6 your -- you need to --
- 7 DIRECTOR MILLNER: I'm withdrawing
- 8 my motion.
- 9 DIRECTOR GANS: And, so, start
- 10 again, with just the Open.
- 11 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Oh, I see. I'm
- 12 following this, now.
- 13 DIRECTOR GANS: Okay.
- 14 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Okay. I make a
- 15 motion that we approve the Meeting Minutes of the
- 16 Open Board Meeting of August 17th, 2017 and
- 17 August 22nd, 2017.
- Do I hear a second?
- 19 DIRECTOR GANS: No. I say that.
- DIRECTOR MILLNER: Oh.
- 21 DIRECTOR GANS: I will -- I will
- 22 second the motion.
- Is there any discussion?
- 24 (No response.)
- DIRECTOR GANS: All in favor?

- 1 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Aye.
- DIRECTOR HARRIS: Aye.
- 3 DIRECTOR GANS: Aye.
- 4 Motion passes three to nothing.

- 6 All right. We're going to ask --
- 7 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Okay.
- 8 DIRECTOR GANS: -- again if we'll be
- 9 out by ten?
- 10 (General chuckles.)
- 11 DIRECTOR MILLNER: No, I gotta do
- 12 this.
- 13 DIRECTOR HARRIS: Actually, I -- I
- 14 move --
- 15 DIRECTOR GANS: I know. That's why
- 16 --
- 17 DIRECTOR HARRIS: -- for the --
- DIRECTOR GANS: -- we'll be --
- 19 DIRECTOR HARRIS: -- (inaudible)
- 20 DIRECTOR GANS: -- out by ten.
- 21 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Give me another
- 22 minute.
- 23 Okay. I make a motion that we
- 24 approve the Minutes of the Closed Board Meetings
- of August 17th, 2017 and August 22nd, 2017.

- 1 DIRECTOR GANS: I will second the
- 2 motion.
- 3 Any discussion?
- 4 (No response.)
- 5 DIRECTOR GANS: All in favor?
- 6 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Aye.
- 7 DIRECTOR HARRIS: Aye.
- 8 DIRECTOR GANS: Aye.
- 9 Motion passes three to nothing.
- 10 Do you have anything else?
- 11 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Oh, yes.
- 12 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Okay. You
- 13 say that, August 17th.
- 14 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Okay. So, I did
- 15 that.
- ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Yes, ma'am.
- 17 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Okay. I can get
- 18 this stack and we'll move on to this.
- 19 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: No, you did
- 20 it.
- 21 DIRECTOR MILLNER: That concludes my
- 22 portion.
- 23 DIRECTOR GANS: Your report? Thank
- 24 you.
- DIRECTOR MILLNER: My report.

- 1 You're welcome.
- 2 DIRECTOR GANS: Moving on to the
- 3 Treasurer's Report.
- 4 We do have a disabled treasurer
- 5 tonight and in his absence I'm going to do the
- 6 Treasurer's Report.
- 7 That was my first job on the Board
- 8 and I'm happy to return to it.
- 9 DIRECTOR HARRIS: And your third.
- 10 DIRECTOR GANS: Yeah, well, we all
- 11 done -- we've all done a few things a few times.
- 12 Right?
- Tonight we have disbursements in the
- amount of \$63,465.46 for the period.
- We have two checks over \$5,000.00,
- 16 which are check 39982 to EKON Benefits for
- 17 \$8,966.00, which is a pension item and it
- 18 includes the quarter -- quarterly allocation
- 19 report for the Welfare Benefit Plan and the
- 20 annual allocation report for the VEBA.
- 21 MS. DEPEW: If you look at -- the
- 22 support is there. It is actually for the 2016
- 23 calculation.
- 24 We did mail them a check back in
- 25 April. They never received it. There's

- 1 indication in there that sometimes their mail
- 2 gets lost.
- 3 So, the original check has been
- 4 voided. It's attached as support and that is the
- 5 issuance for those items.
- 6 DIRECTOR GANS: Thank you.
- 7 MS. DEPEW: You're welcome.
- 8 DIRECTOR GANS: And that check is
- 9 for \$8,966.00, if I didn't already say that,
- 10 because I got lost. It's been a long time.
- 11 And the second check is check 40002
- to Mediclaims for \$5,101.51 and they are our
- 13 billing service for EMS billing.
- 14 Are there any questions about the
- 15 checks?
- 16 (No response.)
- 17 DIRECTOR GANS: No. Since one can't
- 18 talk, --
- 19 DIRECTOR HARRIS: No.
- 20 DIRECTOR GANS: -- he may have
- 21 questions, but we'll never know.
- Jean, do you have any questions?
- DIRECTOR MILLNER: I do not.
- 24 DIRECTOR GANS: All right. And to
- 25 repeat what I always say, my questions are

- 1 emailed to the controller and the chief with a
- 2 copy to the public file.
- I did have check questions, but in
- 4 keeping with the management letter and the
- 5 opinion of the auditors, those were covered by
- 6 email.
- 7 There are a couple of questions and,
- 8 actually, those are in my list, but that's okay.
- 9 On the check run was a credit card
- 10 payment for turnout gear. And I had asked that
- 11 same thing, because it was on their multi-time
- 12 turnout gear bags.
- 13 And the response to it, well, I'll
- 14 -- I'll let the responders respond to it. I know
- 15 what it was.
- 16 (No response.)
- 17 DIRECTOR GANS: All right. I'll
- 18 respond.
- 19 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Well, I do
- 20 know what it is.
- 21 DIRECTOR GANS: Okay.
- 22 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: The bags were
- 23 -- were ordered and because of availability, they
- 24 were delivered as they were available.
- 25 It was a bulk order of 30 bags.

- But, they were delivered as they
- were available and, also, invoiced as they were
- 3 available.
- 4 So it was multiple invoices to equal
- 5 thirty bags.
- 6 DIRECTOR GANS: Okay. And they were
- on there -- there were 60 different line items on
- 8 there.
- 9 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Yes.
- 10 DIRECTOR GANS: And those are bags
- 11 to store the second turnout gear for --
- 12 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: The second
- 13 set of gear. Yes.
- 14 DIRECTOR GANS: -- the second set
- 15 of gear.
- 16 Anything else?
- 17 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Um-hm.
- 18 DIRECTOR GANS: All right.
- 19 So, in reviewing these
- 20 disbursements, they appear to be reasonable and
- 21 necessary in the conduct of the District's
- 22 business.
- 23 Chief -- Chief Spiegel, were these
- 24 checks prepared per your recommendation?
- 25 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Yes, they

- 1 were.
- 2 DIRECTOR GANS: Do they violate any
- 3 state bidding statutes or constitute installment
- 4 payments?
- 5 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: None that I'm
- 6 aware of.
- 7 DIRECTOR GANS: I make a motion that
- 8 we accept the disbursements as prepared.
- 9 DIRECTOR MILLNER: I second the
- 10 motion.
- 11 DIRECTOR GANS: Any discussion?
- 12 (No response.)
- 13 DIRECTOR GANS: All in favor?
- 14 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Aye.
- 15 DIRECTOR HARRIS: Aye.
- 16 DIRECTOR GANS: Aye.
- 17 Motion passes.
- 18 And that concludes the Treasurer's
- 19 Report.
- Let me get back to the Agenda.
- 21 Sorry. I believe we're on the Chief's Report,
- 22 but I want to make sure.
- We are.
- 24 Chief?
- 25 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Yes, sir.

- 1 The -- I've provided manilla folders
- 2 with tab items that are -- item A is -- the
- 3 property committee has reviewed the bids, the two
- 4 bids spec's that we received, the two bids for
- 5 concrete replacement.
- They have recommended Keeley. They
- 7 were the low bid.
- 8 They did our work last year. We
- 9 were happy with the work.
- 10 The caveat to this is that this
- 11 project is over budget.
- 12 I have met with the controller and
- 13 that has been -- that will take a budget
- 14 adjustment, but we would like to complete the
- 15 project.
- 16 DIRECTOR GANS: All right.
- 17 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: And we've got
- 18 the prices. The total price is \$35,820.00 for
- 19 three projects. House One, House Three and House
- 20 Four.
- 21 DIRECTOR GANS: And I have no
- 22 questions about this. We would handle any budget
- amendment at the appropriate time.
- 24 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Yes, sir.
- 25 DIRECTOR GANS: If no one else has

- 1 any questions, I will --
- 2 DIRECTOR HARRIS: What -- what was
- 3 the budgeted amount?
- 4 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Twenty-eight-
- 5 five?
- 6 MS. DEPEW: That's correct.
- 7 DIRECTOR HARRIS: Okay. I -- and I
- 8 realize --
- 9 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: And because
- of this bid process, in -- in next year's budget,
- 11 you'll note that we did ask to include (two words
- 12 not clear).
- 13 DIRECTOR HARRIS: Right. Thank you.
- 14 DIRECTOR GANS: So, I will make a
- 15 motion to accept the bid from L. Keeley
- 16 Construction for the concrete work at House One,
- 17 Three and Four, in the total amount of
- 18 \$35,820.00.
- 19 Do I hear a second?
- 20 DIRECTOR MILLNER: I will second
- 21 that.
- DIRECTOR GANS: Any discussion?
- 23 (No response.)
- 24 DIRECTOR GANS: All in favor?
- DIRECTOR MILLNER: Aye.

- 1 DIRECTOR HARRIS: Aye.
- 2 DIRECTOR GANS: Aye.
- Motion passes three to nothing.
- 4 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Thank you.
- 5 And then tab B, item B is -- I'd
- 6 like to revisit the request for a proposal for a
- 7 -- a new pick-up truck for maintenance.
- I think the explanation required,
- 9 last time, was how the -- how the trucks would be
- 10 re-assigned.
- 11 Do you have any questions regarding
- 12 that explanation?
- 13 DIRECTOR GANS: No, you provided
- 14 that to us --
- 15 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Yes, sir.
- 16 DIRECTOR GANS: -- by email, with
- 17 a copy to the public file.
- 18 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Yes, sir.
- 19 DIRECTOR GANS: All right. So, if
- 20 no one else has any questions, I will --
- 21 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Wait. Well,
- 22 I'm sorry. More specifically, we're prepared to
- 23 advertise September 1st and then close the
- 24 bidding October 2nd, at close of business.
- 25 DIRECTOR GANS: All right. Thank

- 1 you.
- I will make a motion to go out to
- 3 bid for a new 2017 maintenance truck to replace
- 4 2289 with the specifications in the printed bid
- 5 spec, with the -- the period, bid period from
- 6 September 1st, 2017 to October 2nd, 2017.
- 7 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Yes.
- 8 DIRECTOR GANS: Do I hear a second?
- 9 DIRECTOR MILLNER: I will second
- 10 that.
- 11 DIRECTOR GANS: Any discussion?
- 12 (No response.)
- 13 DIRECTOR GANS: All in favor?
- 14 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Aye.
- 15 DIRECTOR HARRIS: Aye.
- 16 DIRECTOR GANS: Aye.
- Motion passes three to nothing.
- 18 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Very good.
- 19 Thank you.
- 20 Item C., Michelle has provided for
- 21 the Board, the July financial's.
- 22 I'll turn this over to Michelle.
- 23 MS. DEPEW: Page 15 are the current
- 24 revenues and expenditures for July.
- 25 Any -- any questions?

- 1 DIRECTOR GANS: Yes. So, we're over
- 2 50 percent through the year.
- MS. DEPEW: Correct.
- 4 DIRECTOR GANS: Or, we're just under
- 5 60 percent and the numbers here give us an
- 6 indication of -- of where we are.
- 7 And I note that we're off by a fair
- 8 amount. It's not a significant amount, but a
- 9 fair amount on both health and dental insurance.
- 10 Is -- are we looking at --
- otherwise, we'd be at six -- at 40 plus percent
- 12 remaining.
- MS. DEPEW: The health and dental --
- and I'll look into that, we get reimbursed by the
- 15 participants on the retiree plan, due to Cobra
- 16 payments and their VEBA payments.
- 17 And I will need to see the
- 18 timeliness. I get those reports from J. W.
- 19 Terrell.
- DIRECTOR GANS: Okay.
- 21 MS. DEPEW: So that fluctuates,
- 22 based upon those payments being made back to us.
- 23 DIRECTOR GANS: Okay. Because, at
- this rate, we wouldn't make it.
- We'd be short.

- 1 So, if you'd look into that, that
- 2 would be great.
- 3 MS. DEPEW: I will.
- 4 DIRECTOR GANS: Also, under vehicle
- 5 maintenance, it looks like we won't make it,
- 6 unless nothing else breaks.
- 7 And, I realize, that when we budget
- 8 for it, we don't know what the costs will be.
- 9 Is there any -- anything that leads
- 10 us to think that it we're just over now and we'll
- 11 end up okay?
- 12 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: I'm not
- 13 anticipating that. We have looked at mixture's
- 14 budget, including cement line items, as well.
- 15 DIRECTOR GANS: Okay.
- 16 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: So, it's
- 17 going to require a budget adjustment. as well.
- 18 DIRECTOR GANS: All right. But, on
- 19 the other hand, if you look at the bottom line,
- and we're okay.
- MS. DEPEW: Correct.
- 22 DIRECTOR GANS: So, it's the detail.
- 23 DIRECTOR HARRIS: We're even back on
- 24 the positive side.
- 25 DIRECTOR GANS: Yes, we are. Easy

- 1 for you to say.
- DIRECTOR HARRIS: Yeah.
- DIRECTOR GANS: Softly. Yes.
- 4 (Referring to Director Harris being unable
- 5 to speak loudly.)
- 6 DIRECTOR GANS: All right. So
- 7 those were all my questions.
- Anyone else have any questions?
- 9 DIRECTOR HARRIS: I have none.
- 10 DIRECTOR MILLNER: I have none.
- 11 DIRECTOR GANS: All right.
- MS. DEPEW: Page 16 are our current
- 13 cash and investments. The next item on the
- 14 Agenda are "Investments."
- 15 DIRECTOR GANS: What kind of
- 16 whopping rates have you gotten for us.
- 17 MS. DEPEW: Well, my recommendation
- is the 13 week at the point six-zero, through the
- 19 CDRS program through Saint Louis Bank.
- The majority of our cash and other
- investments are at UMB and the CDRS program keeps
- us safe and (one word not clear).
- 23 And I think the 13 weeks allows us
- the opportunity to keep reviewing these rates, in
- 25 hopes that they'll go up.

- 1 DIRECTOR GANS: Okay. Saint Louis
- 2 Bank, you said?
- MS. DEPEW: That's correct.
- 4 DIRECTOR GANS: All right. And
- 5 we're talking about a total investment of?
- 6 (No response.)
- 7 DIRECTOR GANS: The other reading
- 8 expiring 8/31?
- 9 MS. DEPEW: That's correct.
- 10 DIRECTOR GANS: So, you haven't
- 11 added them up. I will.
- MS. DEPEW: It's at 3,035,000.
- DIRECTOR GANS: Exactly.
- MS. DEPEW: What I had run, we have
- 15 -- we have currently accumulated 12,000 in
- 16 interest this year on -- on these particular
- 17 items.
- 18 DIRECTOR GANS: All right. I'm
- 19 guessing that because these numbers change, well,
- 20 they don't -- they don't change.
- 21 So this is the amount we're
- 22 investing. Is that correct?
- MS. DEPEW: That is correct. The
- original investment amount is \$3,000,000.00.
- 25 DIRECTOR HARRIS: So it is three

- 1 million thirty-five?
- MS. DEPEW: We've only had -- we've
- 3 had the investments at Saint Louis Bank for two
- 4 years in a row now.
- 5 We continue to re-invest in the CDRS
- 6 program, as designed.
- 7 DIRECTOR HARRIS: We're \$177,000.00
- 8 give-or-take.
- 9 DIRECTOR GANS: Well, the give-or-
- 10 take is what I don't want.
- 11 DIRECTOR HARRIS: No.
- 12 DIRECTOR GANS: So, I'm going to --
- 13 DIRECTOR HARRIS: That's --
- 14 DIRECTOR GANS: -- do it this way.
- 15 DIRECTOR HARRIS: That's it.
- 16 DIRECTOR GANS: All right. So I
- 17 will make a motion to invest those current
- investments, expiring on August 31st, 2017 --
- 19 that's how I'll handle it, in 13 weeks CDRS at
- 20 Saint Louis Bank at point-six percent.
- 21 Do I hear a second?
- 22 DIRECTOR MILLNER: I'll second that.
- 23 DIRECTOR GANS: Any discussion?
- 24 (No response.)
- 25 DIRECTOR GANS: All in favor?

- 1 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Aye.
- DIRECTOR HARRIS: Aye.
- 3 DIRECTOR GANS: Aye.
- 4 Motion passes.
- 5 MS. DEPEW: Thank you.
- 6 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Thank you.
- 7 DIRECTOR GANS: Anything else?
- 8 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: And then the
- 9 additional item E, is an update on the -- the
- 10 Texas -- the status of Texas.
- 11 We have currently kept the Board
- 12 pretty informed.
- 13 DIRECTOR GANS: Yes.
- 14 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Hm-hm.
- 15 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: We have
- 16 currently sent Deputy Chief Crews. He has been
- 17 deployed to Houston. He is a supervising -- a
- 18 supervisor of the Houston Division and very busy.
- I am in contact with him.
- 20 And, also, we have sent our Swift
- 21 Water techs, Captain Towsley, Brian Towsley and
- 22 Captain Richard Levin. They're in the Houston
- 23 area, as well.
- 24 They are actually on boat details
- 25 doing rescues and working very hard.

- 1 We have had additional requests from
- 2 "E-MAC", had a request from Texas for additional
- 3 resources, human resources, too.
- 4 So we are working on -- the
- 5 battalion chiefs are working on two additional
- 6 Swift Water techs.
- 7 So, I don't have names, yet. We're
- 8 working on that, but we're looking at a 24 hour
- 9 deployment and would like the Board's approval to
- 10 -- to provide that.
- 11 DIRECTOR GANS: So, in 24 hours.
- 12 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Yes, sir.
- 13 DIRECTOR GANS: Not for 24 hours.
- 14 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: No. In 24
- 15 hours.
- 16 DIRECTOR GANS: Okay.
- 17 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: It's an eight
- 18 -- eight day deployment commitment.
- 19 DIRECTOR GANS: Okay.
- 20 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: The other
- 21 deployment commitment, Chief Crews and the other
- 22 captains, is a two week possibility.
- DIRECTOR GANS: Okay.
- 24 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Okay.
- 25 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: So I think I

- 1 told you four to seven days. I was corrected.
- 2 DIRECTOR GANS: Okay.
- 3 DIRECTOR MILLNER: Okay.
- 4 DIRECTOR GANS: Thank you.
- 5 You know, it -- it is an opportunity
- for us to help where help is needed.
- 7 We have had times here where we've
- 8 had to call on neighbors in other counties, other
- 9 states, and that help has come our way and I know
- 10 it would in the future.
- 11 And while it can present some
- 12 challenges with staffing and make some of the
- 13 resources here a little bit tight, I know that
- 14 we're able to afford to lend a hand and -- and
- we're pleased to do so.
- I would tell you, if we had to make
- 17 a decision about incurring no costs in doing it,
- 18 I think I know how I would lean, but we are
- 19 reimbursed for --
- 20 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Yes, sir, we
- 21 are.
- 22 DIRECTOR GANS: -- the costs of the
- 23 manpower.
- We just have to provide it.
- 25 And I also am pleased that we

- 1 provide the training and we have qualified
- 2 employees, qualified firefighters and paramedics
- 3 who are able to use their expertise in a
- 4 situation that is very challenging.
- 5 And I'm guessing that they're
- 6 working their tails off, getting little sleep and
- 7 saving lives by the hour.
- 8 So, it's our pleasure, as a Board,
- 9 I speak for the Board, in permitting this and,
- 10 please, just keep us informed.
- 11 And it's been handed to me, by -- by
- 12 the "not speaking too loudly," Director Harris,
- 13 that he believes the Monarch crew in Houston is
- 14 part of a six boat group, which has already
- 15 effected more than 400 rescues.
- DIRECTOR MILLNER: Wow.
- 17 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Yes. So, in
- 18 that level of detail, I got a report from Captain
- 19 Towsley last night that their first deployment
- 20 resulted in -- with the six total boats, Captain
- 21 -- Captain Levin and Captain Towsley reported the
- 22 crew had rescued over 400 people.
- DIRECTOR GANS: Wow.
- 24 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: So sick and
- 25 very sick people, as well. So.

- 1 DIRECTOR GANS: Wow.
- 2 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: So, yes,
- 3 they're working hard.
- 4 DIRECTOR GANS: Okay.
- 5 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: Very skilled
- 6 people, too. Good -- good comment.
- 7 DIRECTOR GANS: Yeah. Okay.
- 8 ACTING CHIEF SPIEGEL: And that
- 9 concludes my report.
- 10 DIRECTOR GANS: All right. Moving
- on to the Attorney's Report.
- 12 MISTER HOFFMAN: Sir, I do not have
- 13 a report, this evening.
- 14 DIRECTOR GANS: All right. Do we
- 15 have any Old Business?
- 16 I'm sorry. Do we have any New
- 17 Business, tonight?
- 18 (No response.)
- 19 DIRECTOR GANS: Any Unfinished
- 20 Business?
- 21 (No response.)
- 22 DIRECTOR GANS: The Agenda for this
- 23 meeting includes a -- the tentative Agenda
- includes a Closed Meeting to follow.
- 25 And, at this time, I will make a

	motion to go into crosed session, pursuant to
2	Missouri Revised Statute 610.021, One, Legal
3	Actions and Advice; Two, Purchase of Real Estate;
4	Three, Personnel matters; Nine, Employee Group
5	Negotiation; Thirteen, Personnel Records.

7	DIRECTOR MILLNER: Second.
8	DIRECTOR GANS: Discussion?
9	(No response.)
10	DIRECTOR GANS: All in favor?
11	DIRECTOR MILLNER: Aye.
12	DIRECTOR HARRIS: Aye.
13	DIRECTOR GANS: Aye.
14	Motion passes three to nothing.
15	We are on in recess from Open
16	session and we are off the record.
17	We will return to Open session after
18	the Closed Meeting is held.

21	called back to order at 8:29 .M., with the
