Please monitor the weather conditions and exercise good judgment the day of your prescribed burn. If you have any concern or question regarding questionable weather conditions, please contact our on-duty Battalion Chief through the emergency dispatch center at the phone number above.

PRESCRIBED BURNS

Prescribed Burn. An outdoor fire utilized for the management of vegetative growth, forest management or wildlife management. This does not include the burning of vegetative waste as a means of disposal. A permit is required for a prescribed burn (see below for prescribed burn permit requirements).

Prescribed Burn Permit.

Prescribed burn permit applications must be submitted to the Fire Prevention Bureau at least 5 days prior to the event. The application may be mailed or delivered to the Fire Prevention Bureau at 13725 Olive Blvd., Chesterfield, MO 63017, or e-mailed to fireprevention@monarchfpd.org. The application must be filled out completely and include the date, time, address of the prescribed burn, and the name and telephone number of a responsible adult who will be on-site for the duration of the burning. Once the application has been received, an on-site inspection will be scheduled. If conditions are acceptable for the fire, the permit will be issued to the applicant.

There is no fee for this permit unless fire department stand-by is needed. If fire department stand-by is needed, the permit fee is \$155.

Since weather conditions may be varied in different areas within the Monarch Fire Protection District, it is your responsibility to monitor the conditions at the location of your planned fire, and take appropriate actions to ensure that the fire will not spread beyond its intended limits.

Additional requirements for prescribed burns:

- The fire shall be constantly attended by a responsible adult until it is extinguished.
- You will need to notify the Fire District emergency dispatch agency before lighting the fire and again after it has been extinguished. The telephone number is listed on the permit.
- A garden hose or other means of extinguishment shall be readily available to extinguish the fire, especially if it should start to spread or become a danger.
- A copy of the permit shall be available at the fire to present to fire or police officers, should they be called to the scene.
- It is also highly recommended that you follow all guidelines, recommendations and practices of the Missouri Department of Conservation for this type of burn.
