## **OPEN MEETING MINUTES**

## **MEETING DATE OCTOBER 19, 2021**

A quorum of the Board of Directors being present, the Open Meeting of the Monarch Fire Protection District for October 19, 2021, is called to Order by Director Gans at 4:00 p.m.

It is further announced that the Open Meeting of the Board of Directors is in session for the transaction of Monarch Fire Protection District business.

<u>Present at the Open Meeting</u>: Director Gans, Director Harris, Director Millner, Fire Chief Spiegel, Assistant Chief Crews and legal counsel Matt Hoffman.

To begin the meeting, everyone in attendance rises to their feet and participates in the Pledge of Allegiance.

After a discussion by the Board of Directors and the administrative staff of the District, there are no changes to the Open Board Meeting Agenda.

There is one (1) public comment during the Open Board Meeting from John Zamudio, a resident of Hazelwood, Missouri, regarding Monarch Fire Protection District benefits, which was answered by the Board of Directors. There are no comments or questions submitted by residents of the Monarch Fire Protection District for a response from the Board of Directors

Under the President's Report, the new school building marking system is discussed during the Open Board Meeting, which will be a universal school labeling system to assist in emergency situations. Ordinance 10-21 to implement the system is reviewed by the Board of Directors with legal counsel.

St. Louis County Councilman Mark Harder is also in attendance to address the development of implementation of the new school building marking system. Under the plan, windows, doors and hallways will be marked and color coded.

It is also noted during the Open Board Meeting that St. Louis area Fire Chiefs and Police Chiefs have been involved in the creation of this system.

Additionally, it is announced that a copy of the inquiries regarding the disbursements were sent electronically to the Public File of the Monarch Fire Protection District.

After discussion, Chief Spiegel states that the checks were prepared per his recommendation and, to his knowledge, the payments do not violate any state bidding statutes or constitute installment payments.
