#### **OPEN MEETING MINUTES**

## **MEETING DATE MAY 1, 2023**

A quorum of the Board of Directors being present, the Open Meeting of the Monarch Fire Protection District for May 1, 2023, is called to Order by Director Millner at 3:01 p.m.

It is further announced that the Open Meeting of the Board of Directors is in session for the transaction of Monarch Fire Protection District business.

<u>Present at the Open Meeting</u>: Director Millner, Director Harris, Director Harvey, Fire Chief Adams, Assistant Chief Crews and legal counsel Mathew Hoffman.

To begin the meeting, everyone in attendance rises to their feet and participates in the Pledge of Allegiance.

After a discussion by the Board of Directors and the administrative staff of the District, there is one (1) change to the Open Board Meeting Agenda, which is the addition of a discussion regarding the meeting date the last week of May under Old Business.

Additionally, there are no citizen comments.

Under the President's Report, District public relations events are reviewed and addressed in detail with Public Education Specialist Ruhl during the Open Board Meeting. Questions are asked by the Board of Directors regarding the public relations budget and specific events planned for the remainder of 2023, including safety trailer activities and safety classes. It is also planned to have an Open House at new Fire House 3 upon completion of construction.
